Minutes of Meeting

Watertower St., Ste. 110, Meridian, ID 83642 to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:00 a.m. (MST) on Thursday, November 16, 2017 with the following Board members present: John Elle, Glenn Bennett, George Wagner, Raymond Watkins, Dusty Obermayer, John Tomkinson and Dr. Murgel. Also present was Keith Simila, Executive Director, Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director, and Jennifer Rowe, Administrative Assistant.

**IV. NEW BUSINESS**

4. Deans and representatives from the Idaho Colleges of Engineering met with the Board to discuss topics such as enrollment, ABET accreditation status, curricula and the progress of faculty licensure.

**I. READING OF MINUTES**

1. Meeting Minutes for the July 31 & August 1, 2017 retreat.

6. NCEES began the search for a new Chief Executive Officer.
7. A draft report of the 2017 Idaho Engineering Talent Pipeline Survey was available for the Board's review.

### **III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

1. Review the Strategic Plan Objectives. The Board noted that there are no changes to the Strategic Plan.
2. Subcommittee Updates
  - a. Surveying FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) Page Subcommittee (Mr. Obermayer, Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee reviews changes to the surveying laws and assists staff with updating the Surveying FAQ web page. Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle are working with Mr. Szatkowski to keep the FAQ current. The Board noted the information.
  - b. QBS Subcommittee (Mr. Wagner, Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee studies whether sub consultant services should be procured using QBS and whether a change in the law for the definition of "agent" will accomplish this. The Board noted the information.
  - c. Surveyor Apprenticeship Subcommittee: (Mr. Bennett, Mr. Elle and Mr. Obermayer) Subcommittee to work with the Department of Labor on survey education and apprenticeship program. The Board noted the information.
3. Mr. Simila presented a draft report on Executive Order 2017-06. The Board noted the information and directed Mr. Simila to prepare the new template for review at the next meeting.
4. John Henderson submitted a question about an article in the Spring 2017 News Bulletin. Attorney Kane provided his response to Mr. Henderson.

5. Mr. Elle and Mr. Bennett provided an update on the ISU surveying program. Mr. Bennett will draft a response for Mr. Simila and Mr. Kane to review. The Board noted the information.
6. The Attorney General's office is investigating a possible case of criminal fraud. An individual is claiming to be license in Idaho when there is no evidence to support that. This investigation is complete and the attorney assigned to it is currently reviewing it. The Board noted the information.


