Minutes of Meeting

The retained surveyor must review and approve in writing, the next 25 records of survey or subdivision plats and all associated descriptions and corner records prior to recording. Further, Respondent must comply with the following:

- 1. The Board must approve the reviewing surveyor.
- 2. The reviewing Professional Surveyor must hold a current license as an Idaho Professional Land Surveyor and may not be under a consent order in any jurisdiction at the time of selection or during the review.
- 3. The reviewing surveyor may not be a relative by blood or marriage and may not be a current or former employer, employee, co-worker or business partner of the Respondent.
- 4. If the reviewing surveyor is a full-time employee, the employer of the reviewing surveyor must consent in writing to their serving in the review capacity. The written consent will be provided to the Board upon request.
- 5. Copies of all preliminary and corrected documents submitted for review will be retained by the reviewing surveyor and provided to the Board on request. All corrected (final) documents accepted by the reviewing surveyor must meet the standard of care and applicable laws, rules and ordinances.
- 6. The reviewing surveyor will provide a report of all documents reviewed, including a certification that the review was performed by him or her personally.
- 7. Any reviewing surveyor who intends to withdraw from their capacity as reviewer shall notify the Respondent and the Board in writing prior to such withdrawal.
- 8. The Respondent will provide these requirements and the reviewing surveyor will acknowledge them in writing to the Board prior to executing any agreement to provide the review services. All costs associated with the review shall be paid by the Respondent.
- 9. The review must include a field inspection by the reviewing surveyor of conditions shown on plats or surveys submitted for review.

As to Count 2: Respondent is fined \$2,500.00. Respondent is hereby suspended from the practice of land surveying. The suspension will be stayed upon Respondent retaining an Idaho Licensed Professional Surveyor to be approved by the Board. The retained surveyor must review and approve in writing, the next 25 records of survey or subdivision plats and all associated descriptions and corner records prior to recording. Further, Respondent must comply with the following:

- 1. The Board must approve the reviewing surveyor.
- 2. The reviewing Professional Surveyor must hold a current license as an Idaho Professional Land Surveyor and may not be under a consent order in any jurisdiction at the time of selection or during the review.
- 3. The reviewing surveyor may not be a relative by blood or marriage and may not be a current or former employer, employee, co-worker or business partner of the Respondent.

- 4. If the reviewing surveyor is a full-time employee, the employer of the reviewing surveyor must consent in writing to their serving in the review capacity. The written consent will be provided to the Board upon request.
- 5. Copies of all preliminary and corrected documents submitted for review will be retained by the reviewing surveyor and provided to the Board on request. All corrected (final) documents accepted by the reviewing surveyor must meet the standard of care and applicable laws, rules and ordinances.
