Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on June 4 & 5, 2012 at the Board Office, 1510 E. Watertower, Ste. 110, Meridian, ID 83642 to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:06 a.m. on Monday, June 4, 2012 with the following Board members present: James H. Milligan, David Bennion, George Wagner and John Howe. Also present was David L. Curtis, Executive Director, Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director and Jennifer Rowe, Administrative Assistant.

George Murgel joined the meeting.

i. AGENDA REVIEW

Are there any new agenda items? There were no additional items to add to the agenda.

I. READING OF MINUTES

1. Review Minutes of the March 27 & 28, 2012 Board meeting.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to approve the minutes of the March 27 & 28, 2012 Board meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

2. Review Minutes of the May 2 & 3, 2012 Board meeting.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to approve the minutes of the May 2 & 3, 2012 Board meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

3. Review Minutes of the May 14, 2012 teleconference meeting.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to approve the minutes of the May 14, 2012 Board teleconference meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

4. Review Minutes of the May 18, 2012 special meeting in conjunction with the NCEES Western Zone Meeting.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Howe to approve the minutes of the May 18, 2012 Board meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

5. Review Minutes of the May 25, 2012 teleconference meeting.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to approve the minutes of the May 25, 2012 Board teleconference meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

1. The following items were continued at previous meetings and staff is unaware of any activity relating to these matters:
 - a. FY11.11 Erickson, Chad, Standard of Care. Mr. & Mrs. Badertscher submitted a complaint regarding the survey work of Chad R. Erickson. The work included locating a previous corner which was apparently incorrectly and previously located by Carl Edwards and others. The location of this corner affects a Badertscher's property line as well as several others. Mr. Erickson submitted a detailed response to the complaint. Staff notified the Badertschers that the complaint lacks the requirements for a formal complaint and will be considered a request for inquiry. Pending outcome of litigation.
2. Mr. Marshall expressed his appreciation to the Board for their help in the approval of his license.
3. A question was raised about the use of the term "engineer" in job titles at Idaho State University. The Board responded that as long as they are not using a title that implies "professional engineer" and are not offering services to the public, they may use a title that has the word "engineer" in it for internal identification purposes. A response was received from Idaho State University.
4. ISPE recommended George Murgel for appointment to the Board.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to note the items on the Consent Agenda with no further action. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Review Strategic Plan Objectives. Staff drafted an amendment to Goal 3 as directed by the Board.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan to add the draft objective to the Strategic Plan. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize staff to work with ISPLS staff to develop a mutually beneficial arrangement for scheduling the item writing workshop in conjunction with the ISPLS meeting. Staff directed to bring details of the arrangement back to the Board for approval. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

3. The State of Washington brought to our attention the services of First American Title Insurance Company and their ExpressMap service. The Board sent a letter and a follow up letter to NSPS requesting any information they might have on the matter. Attorney Kane advised the Board on the feasibility of pursuing this matter.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Wagner to move to continue to this item to the next meeting to see what the State of Washington has done with this matter and monitor ISPLS activity relative to the definition of surveying. Designate Mr. Howe to develop draft language for future changes to the Idaho Code. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

4. Staff was directed to outline a process where licensees are formally notified of their CPD deficiencies, given the opportunity to be heard or the opportunity to enter into a formal Stipulation and Consent Order. Attorney Kane to investigate the need to promulgate a rule requiring submittal of a CPD log with renewal. This item was discussed in conjunction with New Business 10.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

10. Staff drafted a Board Policy relating to the Interpretation of IDAPA Title 1, Chapter 4 Regarding Submittal of CPD Log.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan to accept the updated form and CPD Log policy effective January 1, 2013. Include a NEWS BULLETIN article to explain changes to license holders. Motion passed unanimously.

4. A license holder requested that the Board accept samples of his work in lieu of continuing education.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to authorize the Chair to write to the license holder and inform him that rules allow for numerous means by which to earn PDH's and it does not appear that he has become aware of those opportunities. Motion passed with Mr. Howe voting against the motion and Mr. Elle absent.

7. Mr. Hathaway sent a letter to Mr. Milligan regarding the Board's complaint procedure and practices.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Hathaway, thank him for his thoughts, and let him know that the Board is constrained by the requirements of the Administrative Procedures Act and must provide due process in all instances. Sometimes that results in delays which the parties do not anticipate or appreciate. The Board has a policy of not accepting anonymous complaints or requests for inquiry unless there is an imminent threat to the public health, safety or welfare. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

8. The Board discussed adding an article to the NEWS BULLETIN relating to lessons learned from the recent Board Hearing of FY10.28. The Board directed staff to work with Attorney Kane to develop a list of suggested topics to discuss further at the retreat in August.
11. Mr. Keierleber requested the Board's opinion regarding whether or not building code consultation for non-structural code sections could constitute the practice of engineering.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize the chair to write to Mr. Keierleber and inform him that he may stamp any work that is done under his responsible charge, but he cannot stamp work that was not done under his responsible charge. The IBC does not allow "code compliance analysis" as a substitute for sealed, signed and dated plans. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

12. The Board discussed lessons learned during the recent hearing. This item will be discussed further at the Board Retreat.
13. The Board is currently scheduled to meet August 28-30, 2012. With application review scheduled for the August retreat, does the Board want to look at rescheduling this meeting?

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Wagner to reschedule the meeting to September 6-7, 2012. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent and Mr. Milligan abstained.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan reconsider the previous motion. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to reschedule the meeting to September 5-6, 2012. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

14. Staff drafted changes to the Board Policy on Public Records Requests.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to approve amendments to the Board Policy on Public Records Requests. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

Roll call vote results; Mr. Wagner, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; and Mr. Bennion, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Howe seconded by Mr. Milligan to continue this docket. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

FY11.19 APEX Manufacturing Solutions, LLC, unlicensed practice. The Board continued this matter for more information on what "factory automation integration services" involves. Attorney Kane and Mr. Szatkowski reported their findings to the Board.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Wagner, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; and Mr. Bennion, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Wagner, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; and Mr. Bennion, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Howe to accept the Stipulation and Consent Agreement and authorize the Chair to sign the Final Order. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Skinner and Mr. Ketcham, encourage them to try to resolve this matter for the benefit of their clients and the general public, and short of that, recommend arbitration under the ISPLS auspices be undertaken. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

FY12.12 Dyer, Winston, standard of care. Staff was directed to conduct a preliminary investigation in this matter.

FY12.13 Harper-Leavitt Engineering, Keller Engineering, and Fred Davies. Violation of the Rules of Professional Responsibility. Staff conducted a Preliminary Investigation in this matter.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Howe to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Wagner, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; and Mr. Bennion, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize the Chair to write to all parties and notify them that they should not have responded to the specific request for a

“price” which constitutes a “bid” and is prohibited by IDAPA 10.01.02.009.09.05.
Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize staff to negotiate a Stipulation and Consent Agreement with Mr. Davies regarding his actions in this matter.
Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

FY12.14 Reese, Craig, CPD deficiency. Staff negotiated a Stipulation and Consent Order in this matter.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Milligan to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Wagner, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; and Mr. Bennion, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to accept and authorize the Chair to sign the Stipulation and Consent Order. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

FY12.15 Smith, J. Thomas, CPD deficiency. J. Thomas Smith, P-12311, renewed his license which was due for renewal December 31, 2011, and then wrote indicating that he was deficient in his CPD and would work to complete them over the next eight months. Staff wrote Mr. Smith and informed him that matters such as his were normally given a Stipulation and Consent Order opportunity and if he was agreeable, to work out the details with the prosecuting attorney. A draft order was negotiated for the Board’s review.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Howe to accept the Stipulation and Consent Order and authorize the Chair to sign the Final Order. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

FY12.16 Poole, Kevin & Riedesel Engineering. ROPR

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Wagner, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; and Mr. Bennion, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize the Chair to write to ACEC-Idaho, Governmental Affairs Committee Chair Haener and inform him that the Board is of the opinion that Mr. Poole properly isolated himself, personally, from issues of conflict of interest. In regard to the services of his employer, Riedesel Engineering, Inc., the question is whether or not Mr. Poole is a "principal" or "officer" of the corporation. Neither term is defined in IDAPA, and the Board will further consider the matter to decide whether or not there is a potential violation of IDAPA 10.01.02.008. Attorney Kane is directed to develop further information regarding the definition of "principal" for the Board's review at the next meeting. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2. Subcommittee Updates

- d. International Mobility Subcommittee (Mr. Wagner and Mr. Bennion): The subcommittee will study (1) NCEES administering and selling exams internationally the result of which may be outsourcing of engineering jobs. (2) Foreign engineering students gain their education in the US and then cannot stay. (3) Foreign engineering students gain their education outside the US but come to the US to practice. (4) Foreign engineering students gain their education outside the US, pass the NCEES exams, but do not reside in the US but request licensure in the US. The subcommittee will focus on Idaho procedures. Mr. Wagner wanted to re-scope this issue and provide a progress report to the Board at the June meeting.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize Attorney Kane to investigate the implications of the suggested changes in language and concepts and report his findings to the Board at the September meeting. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

- a. Item Writing (Mr. Howe, Mr. Elle and Mr. Young): The subcommittee is currently in the process of digitizing and reviewing the 110 items that were written during the Item Writing Workshop in March. Approved items will then be sent to the psychometricians for inclusion in the item bank. The Board noted the information.
- b. CM at Risk Subcommittee (Mr. Bennion and Mr. Wagner): The subcommittee will study the Construction-Manager-at-Risk issue. The Board noted the information.
- c. Structural Engineers Subcommittee (Mr. Bennion and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will explore what type of projects should be restricted to structural engineers. Staff was directed to procure laws from other jurisdictions regarding structural engineering requirements. Mr. Bennion

to invite ACEC-Idaho, ISPE, ASCE and SEAI to confer with the subcommittee. The Board noted the information.

- e. FE/FS Exam Expense Subcommittee (Mr. Wagner and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will study ways and means by which the expense of the FE and FS exams could be offset once we move to computer based testing in January 2014. Mr. Curtis prepared suggestions on how to deal with this issue.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to authorize the subcommittee to contact ISPE, ISPLS, ACEC-Idaho and the technical societies and see if they have any interest in taking up the banner on this matter to help students defray the increased cost of the FE and FS exams. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

- f. Surveying FAQ Page Subcommittee (Mr. Howe and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will review recent changes to the surveying laws (effective July 2011) and assist staff with updating the Surveying FAQ web page. The Board noted the information.

5. No one attended the Public Meeting on May 15, 2012 on our Proposed Administrative Rules and we have received no written comments regarding them. The deadline for receipt of written comments was May 23, 2012. Staff requests authorization to publish the Proposed Rules as Pending Rules.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize staff to publish the proposed and temporary rules as Pending Rules. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.

6. Staff requested authorization to submit "Legislative Ideas" for the 2013 session of the Legislature on matters previously discussed including obliterated corners, elevation certifications, filing versus recording of documents, trivial versus *de minimus*, and reissuance of wall certificates.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Wagner to authorize the staff to submit legislative ideas for all of the above ideas except Filing vs. Recording. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Elle absent.




