AND PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYORS

Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on August 2 - 3, 2012 at the Salmon Rapids Lodge in Riggins, Idaho to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:20 a.m. on Thursday, August 2, 2012 with the following Board members present: David Bennion, John Howe, George Wagner, and John Elle. Also present was David L. Curtis, Executive Director and Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director.

i. AGENDA REVIEW

1. Are there any new agenda items? Mr. Bennion would like to add a discussion on Rules of Professional Responsibility – Principal in charge. This item will be added to the agenda under Unfinished Business #8. In addition, Mr. Bennion requests that a discussion of QBS be added. This will be added to the agenda under Unfinished Business #9 and will be discussed as time allows. Mr. Bennion also wants to discuss the transition of staff when Executive Director Curtis retires June 1, 2013. This will be added to the agenda under Unfinished Business #10.

I. READING OF MINUTES

1. Minutes of the June 25, 2012 teleconference meeting.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Wagner to approve the Minutes of the June 25, 2012 teleconference meeting as distributed. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

1. The following items were continued at previous meetings and staff is unaware of any activity relating to these matters:
 - a. FY11.11 Erickson, Chad, Standard of Care. Mr. & Mrs. Badertscher submitted a complaint regarding the survey work of Chad R. Erickson. The work included locating a previous corner which was apparently incorrectly and previously located by Carl Edwards and others. The location of this corner affects a Badertscher's property line as well as several others. Mr. Erickson submitted a detailed response to the complaint. Staff notified the Badertschers that the complaint lacks the requirements for a formal complaint and will be considered a request for inquiry. Pending outcome of litigation.

2. Attorney Kane is in the process of responding to the complainant in the Winston Dyer matter.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Wagner to note the items on the Consent Agenda. Item 2 will be removed from the Consent Agenda and discussed in conjunction with Unfinished Business #5. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Review the Strategic Plan Objectives. The Board noted that there were no additional changes to the Strategic Plan at this time and will defer action until we know more about the Zero-Based Budget process.
2. Jack Clark wrote an editorial for ISPLS relating to legislative ideas for changes in the law to add elevations to definitions of engineering and surveying.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Wagner to authorize staff to draft a letter to Mr. Clark and to the ISPLS Southwest Section with assistance from current and former Board members for Board review at the September meeting. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

6. ISPLS discussed the Board's proposed legislation and offered their comments. This was discussed with Item #2 above.
3. ACEC-Idaho wrote a letter in support adoption of the NCEES Masters or Equivalent model in Idaho. The Board reviewed the letter previously and requested input from ISPE on the matter. This matter was continued for further discussion on the long term strategy of how to build a coalition.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Elle to initiate the creation of a task force of interested and affected professional and technical societies to review potential legislation focused on Masters or Equivalent for civil engineers. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

4. The Board discussed lessons learned from the recent Administrative Hearing. Staff directed to edit the document and make it generic for consideration as a policy to be adopted at the September meeting.
5. Dean Brown requested a status update of his request for a wording change to 54-1215(3b).

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize staff to draft a letter to Mr. Brown in response to his answer to Attorney Kane indicating that the Board reviewed his concern and does not share it, nor have we heard concerns from others mirroring his concern. The Board and Attorney Kane will review the letter at the next meeting. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

7. Subcommittees Updates

- f. Surveying FAQ Page Subcommittee (Mr. Howe and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will review recent changes to the surveying laws (effective July 2011) and assist staff with updating the Surveying FAQ web page.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize the subcommittee to continue refining the revisions and authorize staff to implement as the subcommittee progresses. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

8. Mr. Bennion requested a discussion of the Rules of Professional Responsibility as it relates to Principal in Responsible Charge be added to the agenda. The Board discussed the concept of a "principal in charge" and authorized Mr. Wagner to meet with Attorney Kane to refine the question and define the issue.
9. Mr. Bennion requested a discussion of Qualification Based Selection (QBS) be added to the agenda. The Board discussed the concerns about the fragility of the QBS law and potential dangers of rigorous enforcement of alleged violations of IC 67-2320 by license holders.
10. The Board discussed the transition of staff when Mr. Curtis retires June 1, 2013. The Board discussed the issue of transition when Mr. Curtis retires and asked Mr. Curtis to prepare a job description and prepare a list of tasks with a timeline to be undertaken by the Board to seek a replacement for the position to be presented at the September meeting.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

1. The Board reviewed the proposed Action Items for the NCEES Annual Meeting August 22-25, 2012.
2. Kevin Baker requested a waiver of the additional education needed for those that fail the exam twice or more.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Elle to authorize the Chair to answer the questions in Mr. Baker's correspondence. Motion passed with Mr. Wagner recused and Mr. Murgel absent.

3. The Board previously decided to review applications at the Board Retreat due to the change in the exam deadline from August 1st to July 1st. Was it the Board's intent to review all completed applications (comity and exam) or just exam applications?

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Howe to direct the Board to review all applications that are completed and ready to review. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

4. The annual ACEC-Idaho conference is scheduled for October 4-6, 2012 in McCall, Idaho. Does the Board want to authorize a member to attend?

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Wagner to authorize Mr. Curtis and Mr. Bennion to attend the ACEC-Idaho conference. If Mr. Bennion is not available to attend, a substitute is allowed. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

5. Shawn Martin, PE of ACHD submitted a question regarding the use of Traffic Operations Engineer as a title for an individual that is not a Professional Engineer.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Elle to authorize the Chair to write a letter to Mr. Martin reiterating Mr. Curtis' email interpretation. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

6. A potential applicant submitted a question regarding which IDAPA requirements he will be required to meet in order to sit for the FE exam.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize the Chair to write to the individual and indicate that the requirements in effect prior to March 29, 2012 will be allowed. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.

7. EAC/ABET will be conducting a visit to BYU-Idaho sometime this fall. We also received contact information regarding the Team Chair with a request that they be notified not later than August 31 as to whether or not the Board will be sending an observer.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Elle to authorize Mr. Szatkowski to be the Board Observer. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Murgel absent.
