Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on February 10 & 11, 2014 at the Board Office, 1510 E. Watertower, Ste. 110, Meridian, ID 83642 to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:15 a.m. on Monday, February 10, 2014 with the following Board members present: John Howe, George Wagner, John Elle, David Bennion and George Murgel. Also present was Keith Simila, Executive Director, Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director and Jennifer Rowe, Administrative Assistant.

i. AGENDA REVIEW - Are there any new agenda items?

A new discussion of project management was added to the agenda to be discussed in conjunction with Unfinished Business 2f. Mr. Howe would like the Board to authorize reimbursement of travel expenses incurred due to his participation as a judge in the NCEES Future City competition. This item will be discussed under New Business #1. A discussion relating to the Idaho State Specific exam Part B will be added to the agenda under New Business Item #17. A discussion of ISPE's upcoming annual meeting will be added as New Business #18.

Moved by Dr. Murgel, seconded by Mr. Elle to add new items to the agenda as described. Motion passed unanimously.

Attorney Mike Kane joined the meeting.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

13. Legislation was introduced to remove the requirement that the Director of IDWR be a Professional Engineer. The Board noted the information.

I. READING OF MINUTES

1. Minutes of the November 15 & 16, 2013 meeting.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Dr. Murgel to approve meeting minutes as amended by the Board. Motion passed unanimously.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 2c. International Mobility Subcommittee (Mr. Wagner and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will study (1) NCEES administering and selling exams internationally the result of which may be outsourcing of engineering jobs. (2) Foreign engineering students gain their education in the US and then cannot stay.

- (3) Foreign engineering students gain their education outside the US but come to the US to practice. (4) Foreign engineering students gain their education outside the US, pass the NCEES exams, but do not reside in the US but request licensure in the US. The subcommittee, staff and Board Counsel will further study the existing statutes and rules and see how they apply to consideration of applicants who have been educated and/or licensed in a foreign country and/or obtained their experience outside the United States. The subcommittee concluded that requiring 2 years of US experience would be an acceptable policy. Staff directed to draft proposals on US experience requirement. There is a meeting of the subcommittee scheduled for February 12, 2014. The Board noted the information.
5. Mike Kane provided an opinion on the use of social security numbers by the Board.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Bennion to direct staff to draft a proposal for reworking the application statement for SSN or alternate. Motion passed unanimously.

6. At the last meeting, the Board directed Attorney Kane to contact Coeur D Com about their use of the term engineering. A response was received from Coeur D Com. The Board noted the information.
8. At the November meeting the Board directed staff to revise 54-1234 as needed.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to accept the wording in the proposed statute change. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

5. Chris Renaldo requested Board's opinion on whether or not the new rule regarding conflict of interest preclude engineers and surveyors, who occasionally do work for the County, from holding a volunteer position on a County Planning Commission?

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to direct Attorney Kane to write a letter to Mr. Renaldo clarifying the Board's position. Direct staff to write a NEWS BULLETIN article once the rule is in effect to make sure the interpretation is understood by licensees. Motion passed unanimously.

6. The Board of Architectural Examiners asked if the Board had any formal comments on their proposed law changes. The Board noted the information.
8. The Board discussed the intent of the changes to Idaho Code 54-1202. Mr. Howe drafted a document clarifying the issue.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to send Mr. Howe's response to the individual requesting clarification. Motion passed unanimously.

9. Changes were made to Idaho Code 50-1310 but similar wording was not revised in 50-1304 and 55-1905. The Board may want to draft legislation to correct the oversight.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Bennion to direct staff to work with stakeholders to review the law and recommend changes so that all 3 sections are consistent. Motion passed unanimously.

12. Mr. Simila prepared a report of statute changes before the Legislature in 2015 including modifying the definition of surveying. He has included a communications plan for the Board's review.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Dr. Murgel to require 2 years of boundary Surveying experience as a minimum. Motion withdrawn.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to send a copy of the draft communication plan to ISPLS before the March meeting. Motion passed with Mr. Wagner and Mr. Howe voting against the motion.

VI. CONSIDERATION OF DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

- FY14.02 Elite Edge Engineers, Violations of ROPR. A Stipulation and Consent Order has been negotiated for the Board's review.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Dr. Murgel to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Wagner, yes; Dr. Murgel, yes; Mr. Bennion, yes and Mr. Elle, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to approve the Stipulation and Consent Order as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

- FY14.04 Brown & Caldwell, ROPR. The Board authorized a preliminary investigation into this matter. Holladay Engineering, Inc. sent a letter informing the Board of an agreement that they entered into regarding the City of Middleton. Attorney for Brown & Caldwell asked for an extension of time to the end of February, 2014 to file response. Attorney for Brown & Caldwell and Attorney Naylor requested a 6 month extension on this docket. *FY14.04-FY14.07 is one disciplinary matter.*

- FY14.05 Ayers, Daniel, ROPR. The Board authorized a preliminary investigation into this matter. *FY14.04-FY14.07 is one disciplinary matter.*

- FY14.06 Kelly, Rick, ROPR. The Board authorized a preliminary investigation into this matter. *FY14.04-FY14.07 is one disciplinary matter.*

FY14.07 Melcer, Henryk, ROPR, Unlicensed practice. The Board authorized a preliminary investigation into this matter. *FY14.04-FY14.07 is one disciplinary matter.*

Moved by Dr. Murgel, seconded by Mr. Elle to approve an extension of time for all 4 matters (FY14.04-14.07) of 6 months. Motion passed with Mr. Wagner recused.

FY14.09 Reeve, John Nathan “Nate”, ROPR

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Wagner, yes; Dr. Murgel, yes; Mr. Bennion, yes and Mr. Elle, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Dr. Murgel to close this docket as the violation is de minimus. Motion passed unanimously.

FY14.10 Partner Engineering and Science, Inc., Unlicensed practice. A preliminary investigation was completed.

Moved by Dr. Murgel, seconded by Mr. Wagner to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Wagner, yes; Dr. Murgel, yes; Mr. Bennion, yes and Mr. Elle, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Dr. Murgel to direct Attorney Kane to send a cease and desist letter to Partner Engineering and Science, Inc. and request a list of current projects in Idaho. Mr. Szatkowski directed to look into the inconsistencies of the plat. Motion passed unanimously.

After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to close this matter as de minimus. Motion passed unanimously.

Roll call vote results; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Wagner, yes; Dr. Murgel, yes; Mr. Bennion, yes and Mr. Elle, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to refer this matter to the Prosecuting Attorney for negotiation of a Stipulation and Consent Order. If an agreement cannot be reached, proceed to a hearing. Motion passed with Mr. Wagner recused.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

1. The following items have been continued at previous meetings and staff is unaware of any activity relating to these matters:
 - a. FY11.11 Erickson, Chad, Standard of Care. Mr. & Mrs. Badertscher submitted a complaint regarding the survey work of Chad R. Erickson. The work included locating a previous corner which was apparently incorrectly and previously located by Carl Edwards and others. The location of this corner affects a Badertscher's property line as well as several others. Mr. Erickson submitted a detailed response to the complaint. Staff notified the Badertschers that the complaint lacks the requirements for a formal complaint and will be considered a request for inquiry. Pending outcome of litigation.
 - c. FY13.06 Ruen, Darius, ROPR. Pending resolution of litigation and a determination of whether there are substantive matters to be further investigated. Pending outcome of litigation.
 - d. FY13.10 Bartolome, Todd A., ROPR. Pending decision to move forward from Mr. Ruen.
2. A license holder complimented the updated NEWS BULLETIN layout.
3. The Board received a voluntary retirement notification from Mr. Smith.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to approve the Consent Agenda with no further action. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to reconsider the previous motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to clarify if claims are still pending for FY13.10 and if so, direct staff to draft an order to extend the time for hearing by 6 months. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to accept the Consent Agenda with no further action. Motion passes unanimously.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Review the Strategic Plan Objectives. This item will be continued to the next meeting.
2. Subcommittee Updates
 - a. Item Writing (Mr. Howe, Mr. Elle and Mr. Young): The subcommittee needs to come up with an additional 19 items for item bank. Mr. Szatkowski contacted TEST, Inc. to find out what content is needed for test questions and sent to subcommittee members. The Board noted the information.
 - b. Structural Engineers Subcommittee (Mr. Bennion and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will explore if there is a need, and if so, what type of projects should be restricted to structural engineers. A subcommittee meeting is scheduled.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Dr. Murgel to clarify the charge as restated above. Motion passed unanimously.

- d. Surveying FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) Page Subcommittee (Mr. Howe and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee reviews changes to the surveying laws and assists staff with updating the Surveying FAQ web page. Mr. Howe and Mr. Elle are working with Mr. Szatkowski to keep the FAQ's current. The Board noted the information.
- e. MOE (Master's or Equivalent) for Engineers Subcommittee (Mr. Wagner and Dr. Murgel): The subcommittee will form a task force of interested and affected professional and technical societies to review potential legislation focused on MOE for engineers. Mr. Wagner and Dr. Murgel to pursue the issue and see if a coalition of stakeholders (all disciplines and societies) can be developed. Mr. Wagner has a list of professional organizations that are stakeholders. Mr. Curtis conducted a survey of NCEES Member Board Administrators regarding discipline versus generic licensing and whether there were variable requirements for licensure in different disciplines. Mr. Wagner will coordinate a meeting with the stakeholders. A contact list has been created and the subcommittee will set up a meeting with the stakeholders. A meeting has been scheduled at

the Board office on February 19, 2014. The Board noted the information. Dr. Milligan will be participating as an Emeritus Board member.

- f. Project Manager (Mr. Bennion): Mr. Haener submitted questions relating to the position of Project Manager. Attorney Kane to work with Mr. Szatkowski, Mr. Bennion and Mr. Haener to go over this information. A change to the definition of engineering in 54-1202 was drafted. ACEC will pursue legislation to include “coordination of engineering design, etc” in lieu of including “project management”. Mr. Bennion met with ACEC and they met with AGC and was told that they would not object to the legislation. The legislation is now moving through the legislature. This subcommittee is now considered closed.
 - g. Legislative Idea for Surveying (Mr. Howe and Mr. Elle): Work with ISPLS on changes to the statute regarding the Board’s ruling that “any” means “all” with regard to corner records that must be identified. Subcommittee will work with ISPLS to bring law change back to Board in September, if needed. This legislative idea has been tabled until next year. The subcommittee will present a proposal to ISPLS at the March meeting. The Board noted the information.
3. The House Subcommittee requested that the Board allow an additional year before the new surveying education standard would take effect. The Board previously agreed to this pending outcome of the legislature’s approval of the rule.
 4. Discuss the Board composition. Mr. Simila wrote talking points expressing the need for 2 land surveyors on the Board and increasing the size to 7 members. Staff was directed to contact ISPE, ISPLS and ACEC-Idaho to discuss this matter. Comments have been received from ISPLS. Staff drafted legislation to incorporate a change in Board composition.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to continue to solicit comment on the proposed legislation. Motion passed unanimously.

7. Mr. Simila drafted a proposed rule change that expands the use of credentials evaluations to include all non-EAC/ABET accredited engineering programs. At the November meeting, the Board approved the language for exam applicants and asked that similar language be drafted for comity applicants. In addition, Mr. Simila drafted a change to remove the Board Quorum requirement from the rules.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to accept proposed language change to IDAPA 10.01.01.019.01 and begin the rulemaking process. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Dr. Murgel to accept the proposed language change to IDAPA 10.01.01.20 and begin the rulemaking process. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

1. Reports by Board Members and Staff of activities since the November Board meeting. Mr. Elle attended 2 ISPLS Chapter meetings; participated in 4 subcommittee teleconference meetings and worked on item writing for the state specific exam. Mr. Bennion attended 3 project management subcommittee meetings. Mr. Simila attended 2 ISPLS Chapter meetings in Boise; attended an ACEC meeting and attended the NCEES MBA meeting in Scottsdale, AZ. Dr. Murgel attended the NCEES ACCA committee meeting in Tampa, FL and attended an NCEES FE exam development meeting in Clemson, SC. Mr. Howe attended the ISPLS Board of Governors December meeting; participated as a judge in the NCEES Future City competition and continued to work on item writing for the state specific exam.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to approve reimbursement of travel expenses for Mr. Howe's participation in the NCEES Future City event. This event is approved for future Board member attendance and reimbursement as well. Motion passed unanimously.

Staff provided an update on the Board's financial status as of December 31, 2013. The Board noted the information.

3. Staff prepared an Expense Reimbursement Summary for the Executive Director for November 2013 through December 2013 for the Board's review.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Dr. Murgel to approve the expense reimbursement summary as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Dr. Murgel to authorize costs associated with continuing the NEWS BULLETIN in the new format. Motion passed unanimously.

4. An applicant was recently denied assignment to the FS exam because the application did not contain evidence of completion of the prescriptive course requirements listed in IDAPA 10.01.01.017.02. The applicant enrolled in the surveying curriculum at the University of Wyoming and would like to know if that would be considered a "student in the last 2 semesters" for assignment to the exam.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to assign applicant to the FS exam contingent on submittal of an official transcript. FS certificate will be held until proof of completion of prescriptive courses is obtained. Motion passed unanimously.

7. An applicant for comity licensure with multiple failures of the PE exam requests waiver of additional education.

Moved by Dr. Murgel, seconded by Mr. Bennion to continue application pending an interview at the next board meeting to discuss applicant's credentials and for review of CPD log. Motion passed unanimously.

10. Mr. Simila requested the Board's authorization to attend the ISPLS conference March 4-7, 2014 in Pocatello.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize Mr. Simila's attendance at the ISPLS conference in March. Motion passed unanimously.

11. A license holder requested that late fees be waived on his renewal for extenuating circumstances.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Dr. Murgel to deny fee waiver but grant exemption from CPD per the rule for individuals out of country. Motion passed unanimously.

14. The Board received information from PNWER about the Annual Summit.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Elle to authorize attendance of the Board Chair and Executive Director for the PNWER Annual Summit. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Elle to recess the meeting at 5:15 p.m. on February 10, 2014. Motion passed unanimously.

The meeting reconvened at 8:00 a.m. on February 11, 2014.

VI. CONSIDERATION OF DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

FY14.03 Miller, William. Mr. Miller is a current Idaho licensee and has had a Calif. License. In California he let his license lapse, but did engineering on a wastewater treatment facility for the City of Brawley, CA. That engineering resulted in litigation and a negotiated settlement with the City of Brawley by the firm Mr. Miller worked for in the amount of \$1.3M paid by their insurance carrier. This settlement was found by the CA Board and Mr. Miller had not notified them. He was subsequently disciplined by them as an unlicensed individual. He has not complied with their order. He also has not noted either issue on the past two Idaho renewals. This case is all a matter of record. A Stipulation and Consent Order has been drafted for the Board's review.
