IV. NEW BUSINESS

7. Legislative Idea for Surveying (Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle): Work with ISPLS on changes to the statute regarding the Board's ruling that "any" means "all" with regard to corner records that must be identified. Law and rule changes are in progress and approved by the governor's office. The Board noted the information.
 - e. Board composition (Mr. Wagner and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee will vet the proposed legislation in regards to changes in number of Board members with the stakeholders. Legislation was proposed and approved by the Governor's office. The Board noted the information.

Other factors may be economic decline (fewer jobs, less demand), experience requirement in our law only considers boundary surveying therefore it takes longer than 4 years to meet the experience requirement and the removal of surveying from Civil Engineering course requirements. Motion passed unanimously.

10. Tom Judge, PLS submitted a question regarding rooftop lease site surveys for the Board's opinion. Mr. Elle and Mr. Bennett will respond to the questions. The Board noted the information.




