Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on June 10, 2015 at the Coeur d'Alene Inn, 506 W. Appleway Ave., Coeur d'Alene, ID 83814 to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:00 a.m. (PST) on Wednesday, June 10, 2015 with the following Board members present: George Wagner, John Elle, George Murgel, David Bennion and Glenn Bennett. Also present was Keith Simila, Executive Director and Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director. Jennifer Rowe, Administrative Assistant joined the meeting by phone.

I. READING OF MINUTES

1. Meeting Minutes for the April 9 & 10, 2015 meeting.

Moved by Mr. Bennett, seconded by Dr. Murgel to approve the minutes from the April 9 & 10, 2015 meeting as distributed. Motion passed unanimously.

After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

FY11.11 Erickson, Chad, Standard of Care. Mr. & Mrs. Badertscher submitted a complaint regarding the survey work of Chad R. Erickson. The work included locating a previous corner which was apparently incorrectly located by Carl Edwards and others previously. The location of this corner affects the Badertscher's property line as well as several others. Mr. Erickson submitted a detailed response to the complaint. Staff notified the Badertschers that the complaint lacks the requirements for a formal complaint and will be considered a request for inquiry. Attorney Naylor will bring the Board up to date on this matter. This matter has been extended until June 15, 2015.

Surveying FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) Page Subcommittee (Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee reviews changes to the surveying laws and assists staff with updating the Surveying FAQ web page. Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle are working with Mr. Szatkowski to keep the FAQ current. The Board noted the information.
 - c. Boundary Experience Requirements (Mr. Bennett and Mr. Elle): The subcommittee worked on what the minimum boundary surveying experience requirements should be for applicants for licensure. The subcommittee proposed issuance of a temporary rule to require 2 years minimum boundary experience. The Board noted the information.

Mr. Bennion attended the NCEES Western Zone and worked with ACEC-Idaho and ISPE on the conflict of interest rule. Dr. Murgel attended the NCEES Western Zone meeting and a NCEES FE exam committee meeting. Mr. Elle attended an ISPLS chapter meeting; attended the ISPLS Board of

Governors meeting; answered questions from surveyors and land owners and gained approval from ISPLS for a CP&F form contest for surveyors.

9. Model Law Surveyor – Does the Board want to unconditionally approve ABET - EAC, ASAC, and ATAC accredited survey programs?

10. Staff proposed a rule change for international comity – The Board needs to go on record as considering the Canadian and perhaps UK licensing system as substantially equivalent to Idaho's requirements per the new rule.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to approve the licensure process for Canadian Professional Engineers. Staff directed to bring back information of the UK licensure process. Motion passed unanimously.




