Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on June 2 & 3, 2016 at the Board Office, 1510 E. Watertower St., Ste. 110, Meridian, ID 83642 to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:00 a.m. (MST) on Thursday, June 2, 2016 with the following Board members present: John Elle, George Murgel, Glenn Bennett, David Bennion, Dusty Obermayer and Raymond Watkins. I. READING OF MINUTES

1. Meeting Minutes for the March 1, 2016 meeting.
