Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on September 4 – 6, 2008 at the Owyhee Plaza, 1109 Main St., Boise, Idaho, to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, September 4, 2008 with the following Board members present: John W. Howe, William J. Ancell, Gary Young, James H. Milligan, and David Bennion. Also present was David L. Curtis, Executive Director, Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director, Mike Kane, Board Attorney, and Jennifer Rowe, Administrative Assistant.

VI. DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

FY08.08 Hosac, Steven W., failure to complete CPD units. An Administrative Hearing was held at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 4, 2008. Mr. Hosac did not attend the hearing.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Bennion to enter into executive session to discuss disciplinary matters as provided for in Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to exit executive session. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Ancell to suspend Mr. Hosac's Professional Land Surveyor license for one year; issue a \$2,000 administrative penalty payable to the Board within 60 days; require Mr. Hosac to complete 6 credits of land surveying coursework as described in 10.01.01.019.01(c), and complete a 2 credit approved ethics course. All coursework must be completed within one year. Failure to comply with any condition of this motion will result in license revocation without further hearing. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize Counsel to prepare the Final Order for the Chair's signature. Motion passed unanimously.

V. CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS

INTERVIEWS

Rick Marbury joined the meeting to discuss his application to sit for the Principles and Practice of Engineering examination for the 4th time. Mr. Marbury presented his current study materials and discussed exam preparation.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Young to approve Mr. Marbury's request to sit for the Principles and Practice of Engineering examination in October 2008 providing he meets the following conditions: (1) complete the NSPS correspondence course and forward a copy of the Certificate of Completion to the Board office and (2) submit a copy of an exam from that course that has been graded and on which he received a passing score before October 10, 2008. Upon failure of either condition, assignment to the October 2008 exam will be withdrawn and the Board will reconsider his assignment to the April 2009 exam. Motion failed with Mr. Young and Mr. Bennion voting in favor of the motion.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Bennion to request that Mr. Marbury complete the NSPS course and bring a Certificate of Completion and a graded sample exam with a score above 70 to the February 2009 Board meeting for the Board's review. Mr. Marbury is directed to contact the Board office and schedule an appointment for the February meeting. Motion passed with Mr. Milligan and Mr. Ancell voting against the motion.

Mr. Marbury left the meeting.

Ricardo Calderon joined the meeting to discuss his application to sit for the Fundamentals of Engineering examination for the 4th time. Mr. Calderon discussed his current exam preparations and requested that the Board assign him to the April 2009 exam. Mr. Ancell stated that he would work with Mr. Calderon on his study plan.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Young to postpone action on Mr. Calderon's request until the November meeting to allow time for Mr. Ancell and Mr. Calderon to work out a study plan. Mr. Calderon will meet with Mr. Ancell on September 12, 2008 to discuss plan further. Motion passed with Mr. Milligan and Mr. Ancell voting against the motion.

Mr. Calderon left the meeting.

I. READING OF MINUTES

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Ancell to approve the minutes from the June 11-14, 2008 meeting as distributed. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Approve the minutes from the August 1 & 2, 2008 Board retreat as distributed.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to approve the minutes from the August 1-2, 2008 Board Retreat as distributed. Motion passed unanimously.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

1. ABET released the 2007 Annual Report.
2. Mike Kane restructured his law firm.
3. NCEES notified the Board of volunteer opportunities with the Engineer Your Life program.
4. The following items were continued at previous meetings and staff is unaware of any activity relating to these matters:
 - a. FY05.23: Soderling, Alan R., P.E. violations of the rules of professional responsibility. Soderling and J-U-B appealed the District Court ruling to the Idaho Supreme Court. Mr. Erickson re-filed this complaint with the Board office and the Board extended the 6 month time frame in order to allow the Supreme Court decision to be heard.
 - b. FY07.09: Dreyer, Robert P., violations of the rules of professional responsibility. The Board granted Mr. Dreyer an extension until July 31, 2008 to submit a draft amended ROS and Corner Records.
 - c. FY07.16: Bybee, Scott, unlicensed practice of land surveying. The Board granted Mr. Bybee an extension until June 30, 2008 to complete the requirements of the Stipulation and Consent Agreement.

An ORDER extending the time until 6 months after the end of litigation has been signed.
 - e. FY08.23a: Munio, Albert, unlicensed practice
FY08.23b: Bessaw, John W., P.E., violations of statutes and Rules of Professional Responsibility
FY08.23c: Washington Group International, violations of statutes and Rules of Professional Responsibility. An ORDER extending the time until 6 months after the end of litigation has been signed.
 - f. FY08.28 Flynn, Donald E., disciplinary action taken in Oklahoma. This item has been continued until such time as he completes his probationary period in Florida.

- g. FY08.36 Pace, Garry, incompetent practice. This item is continued until such time as Mr. Pace completes the requirements of the Consent Order.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Milligan to remove items 4(b) and 4(c) for discussion, note remaining items on the Consent Agenda with no further action. Motion passed unanimously.

VI. DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

- FY07.16 Bybee, Scott, unlicensed practice of land surveying. The Board granted Mr. Bybee an extension until June 30, 2008 to complete the requirements of the Stipulation and Consent Agreement. Mr. Bybee did not complete the requirements.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Ancell to authorize staff to proceed with a hearing as outlined in the Stipulation and Consent Order. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Bennion absent.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

3. A subcommittee consisting of Mr. Ancell, Mr. Young, Mr. Curtis and Mr. Kane was formed to discuss sealing procedures at Idaho Transportation Department on long term projects. Staff was directed to develop additional changes for suggested legislation relating to the licensee in responsible charge.

Moved by Mr. Ancell, seconded by Mr. Milligan to postpone this item to the November meeting. Staff directed to include draft language of addition to 54-1223 on agenda for November. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Bennion absent.

4. Mike Kane presented information to the Board on conflict of interest, open meetings and lobbying.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Ancell to postpone this discussion to the November meeting. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Bennion absent.

5. A subcommittee consisting of Mr. Milligan, Mr. Bennion, and Mr. Young met with leadership at ITD to discuss the details of the Phase IV Geotechnical report. The subcommittee met with Greg Laragan, Deputy Chief Operations Engineer at ITD. Mr. Laragan will report to the Board as this issue progresses through ITD. The Board noted the information.

VI. DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

- FY08.38 Hodge, Larry, Survey Practices. This matter was continued pending the outcome of litigation. On August 22, 2008 we received word from Mr.

Kane that an attorney for one of the parties reported to him that the matter has been settled. Mr. Kane provided an update to the Board.

The Board voted by roll call vote to enter into executive session to discuss disciplinary matters as provided for in Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results - Mr. Bennion, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Ancell, yes and Mr. Young, yes.

The Board exited executive session.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize a preliminary investigation in this matter to be performed by a Professional Land Surveyor to be named later with input from Kirt Naylor and guidance by staff as to proper conduct of investigation and report preparation. Staff was directed to contact Glen Bennett as a potential investigator. Motion passed unanimously.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

6. After a discussion at the June meeting, the Board requested that ACEC-Idaho submit correspondence to the Board relating to additional issues of geologists stamping materials reports and lagoon leakage testing.

Moved by Mr. Ancell, seconded by Mr. Young to form a subcommittee of Mr. Milligan, Mr. Bennion and/or Mr. Young to meet with subcommittee from the Board of Professional Geologists to discuss the DEQ rule which allows Professional Geologists to seal lagoon testing documents. Staff directed to set up meeting as soon as feasible. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

2. Bob Jones, PLS requested that the Board review a note for Engineers on preliminary road plans.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Jones and indicate that the Board does not see a problem with the use of the language suggested except that it should say "The Professional Engineer who is in responsible ~~change~~ charge ~~for~~ of the preparation of these Preliminary Roadway Plans certifies that he has complied with Title Section 55, Chapter 16 -1613 of the Idaho Code as to the existence and location of found survey monuments. He is not responsible for the preparation of the Final Roadway Plans or the construction of the roadway." Before the Professional Engineer could sign such a statement, he would need to have adequate documentation from the Professional Land Surveyor on the matter. Staff directed to include this information in the next NEWS BULLETIN. Motion passed unanimously.

4. When a Professional Engineer prepares a legal description, should they stamp it?

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Ancell to express concern on this topic because Professional Engineers are not authorized to conduct boundary surveys. If they prepare a legal description, the Board is of the opinion that their work product is a "report" which under 54-1215 must be sealed, signed and dated. Motion passed unanimously.

5. The Software Engineering Licensure Consortium asked the Board to support the development of a NCEES software engineering examination.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Ancell to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Kinney and indicate that the Idaho Board has not been made aware of a need for such an examination as required by the NCEES Policy for the development of a new examination. Motion passed unanimously.

6. Gary Briant submitted a question in regards to the timing to set R/W monumentation and filing a R/W plat or ROS.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize the Chair to sign letter to Mr. Briant informing him that the law does not address the issue of when monumentation must occur during the acquisition of property. The timing of the monumentation is a contractual issue to be determined between the surveyor and client. The Board has formed a subcommittee of Mr. Young and Mr. Howe to review and better define the process of monument placement. Motion passed unanimously.

7. Matthew Cash informed the Board that he was denied access to a past project.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Cash and inform him that we are not aware of any Idaho law or rule that applies to this situation. Motion passed unanimously.

8. Mr. Pestotnik was practicing engineering on an expired license for 9 years. He recently renewed his license and provided a reason for his failure to renew.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize staff to negotiate a Stipulation and Consent Agreement with Mr. Pestotnik for Board consideration. Motion passed unanimously.

9. Quadrant Consulting submitted documentation relating to a disciplinary action that was pending when they renewed the Certificate of Authorization. The COA renewal was been placed in pending status.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize the Chair to write to Quadrant, thank them for their response, but indicate that the intent of the question was whether there are allegations of wrongdoing pending before a licensing board, not civil lawsuits. Staff directed to draft new language for Certificate of Authorization renewal form clarifying intent of the question and present to the Board for review. Motion passed unanimously.

11. John Howe requested an opinion from the Board on when a land surveyor stakes out a drain field easement (septic) with iron rods – is he required to file a ROS?

Moved by Mr. Ancell, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize staff to draft a NEWS BULLETIN article stating that the Board opinion is that if a surveyor sets monuments to delineate a drain field easement location, a survey has been performed and under Idaho Code Section 55-1904 (2) and (3), a Record of Survey must be prepared and filed. Motion passed unanimously.

14. Dwaine Thomson, Building Official of Twin Falls, submitted a question regarding a permit.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize staff to conduct a preliminary investigation into the matter. Motion passed unanimously.

VI. DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

The Board voted by roll call vote to enter into executive session to discuss disciplinary matters as provided for in Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results - Mr. Bennion, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Ancell, yes and Mr. Young, yes.

The Board exited executive session.

FY08.09 Jordan, Frederick E., failure to complete CPD units. License has been suspended for one year. Is required to complete 6 credits for land surveying coursework and complete a 2 credit approved ethics course. As of August 20th, the \$2,000 fine had not been received.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize the Chair to sign a FINAL ORDER revoking Mr. Jordan's license. Motion passed unanimously.

FY08.14 Millar, John Wayne, failure to complete CPD units. License has been suspended for one year. Is required to complete 6 credits for land surveying coursework and complete a 2 credit approved ethics course. As of August 20th, the \$2,000 fine had not been received.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize the Chair to sign a FINAL ORDER revoking Mr. Millar's license. Motion passed unanimously.

FY08.33 Droulard, Joel, violations of ROPR. Docket was continued at previous meeting pending an outcome to the current litigation. The lawsuit was dismissed without prejudice. Does the Board want to extend the 6 month time limit?

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize a preliminary investigation in this matter to be performed by a Professional Land Surveyor to be named later with

input from Kirt Naylor and guidance by staff as to proper conduct of investigation and report preparation. Staff directed to contact Clyde Porter or Glen Bennett as potential investigators. Counsel directed to prepare a notification of extension of time to be signed by Chair. Motion passed unanimously.

FY08.41 Root, John, survey practices

Mr. Young recused himself from the discussion.

Moved by Mr. Ancell, seconded by Mr. Bennion to direct staff to proceed with a preliminary investigation in this matter including a listing of the last two years of surveys as previously requested. The Board authorized Counsel to prepare an ORDER for signature by the Chair extending time limit. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Young recused.

FY09.01 Green, Richard, rules of professional responsibility

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize staff to conduct a preliminary investigation in this matter. Motion passed unanimously.

FY09.02 McGimpsey, John, unlicensed practice

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Ancell to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. McGimpsey thanking him for his response and letting him know that the Board considers the matter closed. Motion passed unanimously.

FY07.09 Dreyer, Robert P., violations of the rules of professional responsibility. The Board granted Mr. Dreyer an extension until July 31, 2008 to submit a draft amended ROS and Corner Records.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Milligan to authorize the Chair to sign a letter to Mr. Dreyer enumerating concerns about his survey and corner records, ask him to make changes and resubmit to the Board, then file after approval by Mr. Howe and Mr. Young. Board requests that he provide an explanation of services provided in Idaho by Lantech. Motion passed unanimously.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Review Strategic Plan Objectives. The board reviewed the Strategic Plan and modified the deadline to complete Goal 3 Objective B to December 1, 2008. The Board added a new objective under Goal 3 to revise the application process for the fundamentals examinations to expedite the process for applicants. Goal 5 Objective A was removed as this objective has been completed. The deadline to create desk manuals under Goal 5 Objective B was modified to April 30, 2009.

2. The subcommittee to work with the Board of Architectural Examiners to clarify the definitions of engineering and architecture reported to the Board. As directed, staff submitted a "Legislative Idea" to the Division of Financial Management although actual legislation may not be ready for 2009 session. Should staff withdraw the "Legislative Idea"?

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize staff to withdraw the Legislative Idea. Motion passed unanimously.

7. A subcommittee of Mr. Howe and Mr. Young met with stakeholders and has drafted possible amendments to Idaho Code Title 55 Chapter 17, Coordinate System of Land Description. The subcommittee and stakeholders intend to more widely circulate the possible amendments to other stakeholders for comments and suggestions. The subcommittee met in early August to work on rewording the Idaho Code. The subcommittee decided that draft legislation would not be ready in time for the 2009 legislative session and requests that the legislative idea be withdrawn.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize staff to withdraw this legislative idea. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

1. Reports by Board Members and Staff of activities since the last Board meeting.

All Board members, Mr. Curtis and Mr. Szatkowski attended the NCEES Annual Meeting in Minneapolis, MN and the Board Retreat in Riggins, ID. In addition, Mr. Milligan attended the Negotiated Rule Making Workshop in Lewiston; a CEC committee meeting in Clemson, SC; attended the PNWER Annual Summit; attended the ACEC-Idaho Annual Meeting at Tamarack; met with the Governor's staff in Boise to discuss Board business and met with ITD regarding signing of Phase 4 reports. Mr. Ancell met with the Governor's staff in Boise to discuss Board business. Mr. Bennion met with ITD to discuss the signing of Phase 4 reports. Mr. Young attended Negotiated Rule Making Workshops in Idaho Falls, Twin Falls, and Pocatello; attended the Idaho State Plane Coordinate meeting in Boise and interviewed 5 examinees for third assignment. Mr. Howe attended the Idaho State Plane Coordinate meeting in Boise, and he has been assigned to work on the EPS subcommittee and Calculator subcommittee for NCEES. Mr. Curtis attended all Negotiated Rule Making Workshops throughout the state; attended the PNWER Annual Summit; attended the Idaho State Plane Coordinate meeting; attended the ACEC-Idaho Annual Meeting at Tamarack and made a presentation to the University of Idaho electrical engineering students. Mr. Szatkowski attended the Negotiated Rule Making Workshops around the state.

3. Mr. Curtis requested authorization to attend the APEGBC Annual Conference and AGM October 16-18, 2008 in Kelowna, BC.

Moved by Mr. Milligan, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize Mr. Curtis and Mr. Young to attend the APEGBC annual Conference. Motion passed unanimously.

10. Staff prepared a summary of the financial impact of passing all exam fees through ELSESES as well as a draft strike-and-underscore of the necessary law changes.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Ancell to approve proposed legislation with provision that if it passes, an application fee will not be charged to the fundamentals applicants. Motion passed with Mr. Milligan and Mr. Bennion voting against the motion.

12. Land Tech submitted their Certificate of Authorization renewal and it was postmarked August 1, 2008. They were charged a \$10.00 penalty for not having paid the renewal in July. Land Tech requested that the Board waive the penalty.

Moved by Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Milligan to deny request to waive penalty. Motion passed unanimously.

13. Staff submitted a budget request as reflected in the Executive Summary link. Revenue projections are based on the FY10PROJ link.

Moved by Mr. Ancell, seconded by Mr. Young to accept budget as prepared by staff. Motion passed unanimously.

VI. DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

- FY08.21 ABC Drafting & Design Services, unlicensed practice. The Board directed Counsel to send a draft complaint and injunction to ABC Drafting and Design Services and notify them of the Board's intent to proceed with legal action if they don't change the web site and continue to offer engineering services without a COA through an "engineering partner".

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Young to authorize staff to work with Mr. Kane to develop a more specific letter outlining the concerns of the Board about the use of a term like "structural design services," and that the asterisk on the website implies there is a "plan-stamper" on board. Motion passed unanimously.
