Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on June 7 – 8, 2011 at the Best Western Coeur d'Alene Inn, 506 W. Appleway Ave., Coeur d'Alene, ID 83814 to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:10 a.m. on Tuesday, June 7, 2011 with the following Board members present: James H. Milligan, David Bennion, John Howe, George Wagner, and John Elle. Also present was David L. Curtis, Executive Director and Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director. Jennifer Rowe, Administrative Assistant was present via telephone.

i. AGENDA REVIEW

Are there any new agenda items? Mr. Milligan would like to add a discussion relating to cell phone usage during Board meetings. The Board will discuss this matter under NEW BUSINESS #14.

I. READING OF MINUTES

1. Review Minutes of the April 7-8, 2011 meeting.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to approve the minutes of the April 7-8, 2011 meeting as distributed. Motion passed unanimously.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

1. The following items have been continued at previous meetings and staff is unaware of any activity relating to these matters:
 - a. FY10.09 Lund, Michael, Rules of Professional Responsibility. On advice of Counsel, the investigation was halted pending the outcome of an investigation by the Office of the Attorney General. An ORDER extending the time until 6 months after the end of litigation has been signed.
 - b. FY10.18 Forsgren Associates, Inc. Rules of Professional Responsibility. This matter was continued pending the outcome of civil litigation.
 - c. FY11.04 TCGroup, Inc., unlicensed – no COA. TCGroup applied for a Certificate of Authorization. TCGroup, Inc., had two engineers apply for licensure and will get a COA when one of the individuals obtains an Idaho license.
 - d. FY11.11 Erickson, Chad, Standard of Care. Mr. & Mrs. Badertscher submitted a complaint regarding the survey work of Chad R.

Erickson. The work included locating a previous corner which was apparently located incorrectly previously by Carl Edwards and others. The location of this corner affects the Badertscher's property line as well as several others. Mr. Erickson submitted a detailed response to the complaint. Staff notified the Badertschers that the complaint lacks the requirements for a formal complaint and will be considered a request for inquiry. Staff found that the matter is under litigation and is scheduled for trial in September 2011. The Board placed this matter on hold pending completion of the litigation.

2. With input from the Board and staff, ISPE, ISPLS and ACEC-Idaho have developed a Memorandum of Understanding regarding nominations for upcoming Board positions.
3. Mr. Chapin submitted comments to the Board.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Wagner to note the items on the consent agenda with no further action. Motion passed unanimously.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Attorney Mike Kane joined the meeting by telephone.

2. Subcommittee Updates
 - c. Obligation to Communicate Discovery of Discrepancy (David Bennion and George Wagner): Mr. Bennion and Mr. Wagner were directed to take the draft language back to the subcommittee and ask that language be added that provides a process for documentation of a material discrepancy that is not responded to by the licensee or certificate holder after there has been an informal discussion regarding the alleged error. Mr. Kane provided suggestions for alternative language.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to accept the language as revised and submit as a Proposed Rule. Motion passed with Mr. Howe and Mr. Elle voting against the motion.

4. The Board asked staff to draft a letter to individuals that submit requests for inquiry or complaints regarding surveying to the Board. Staff drafted a letter for the Board to review.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Elle to approve letter as revised. Motion passed unanimously.

5. A public meeting was held on May 11, 2011 to present draft rule changes to the public. The Board reviewed the comments from that meeting.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Howe to approve a 2 year limitation on the acceptance of an affidavit in Docket 10-0102-1101. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Elle to change “may” to “shall” after failure to respond to initial contact in Docket 10-0102-1101. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Howe to add “chapter” in four places and leave 10 PDH as is in Docket 10-0104-1101. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

3. The Board will select meeting dates for calendar year 2012.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to accept the suggested calendar with staff directed to study process change to reduce schedule conflicts or tightness of schedule with other meetings. Motion passed unanimously.

6. Mr. Rodney Jones, PLS requested the opinion of the Board regarding monumenting.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Elle to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Jones and inform him that the Board does not determine liability, but that he cannot place his PLS number on the monument if he was not in responsible charge of the work to determine that the monument is placed at the corner location. The Board suggests that he consider meeting with ITD to see if they will alter contracts to allow the PLS who was in responsible charge of the work to place his/her PLS number on the monument and file a Record of Survey. A copy of the response will be sent to ITD. Motion passed unanimously.

8. Can a licensed PLS maintain responsible charge without direct supervision of the survey crew?

Moved by Mr. Elle, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize the Chair to write to Mr. Ruiz and inform him that there is insufficient information in his inquiry for the Board to respond. Please provide the details of the situation with which you are dealing. Motion passed unanimously with Mr. Bennion absent.

9. ISPLS submitted questions relating to HB 132.

Mr. Milligan appointed Mr. Howe, Mr. Elle and Mr. Young (pending an appointment to Emeritus Member) to draft a response for consideration by the entire Board.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Elle to enter into executive session to consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided for by Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Roll call vote results; Mr. Howe, yes; Mr. Elle, yes; Mr. Milligan, yes; Mr. Bennion, yes; and Mr. Wagner, yes. After meeting in executive session, the Chairman directed the Board to return to regular session.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Elle to dismiss all matters in the request for inquiry as unfounded or not within Board jurisdiction except the Emmett Waste Water Treatment plant issue which the Board will continue pending the outcome of litigation if it comes about. If it does not, we will pursue the matter further. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Kane left the meeting.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Review Strategic Plan Objectives.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to accept changes to Strategic Plan and direct staff to submit updated plan as required. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Subcommittee Updates

- a. Item Writing (John Howe and Gary Young): The subcommittee reported to the Board on their review and evaluation of the new questions from the Item Writing Workshop. Staff was directed to explore item banking software options and received a proposal from Test, Inc. for Item Banking and Test Assembly Services.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize staff to enter into an agreement with TEST, Inc. for the services contained in the proposal. Motion passed unanimously.

- b. SWPPP (David Bennion, Jim Milligan and Jim Szatkowski): The subcommittee was directed to work with the ITD Rapid Action Team to find a resolution to this matter. The subcommittee has scheduled a meeting for July 27, 2011. The Board noted the information.
- d. Idaho Code 33-356 allows that School Districts may seek to qualify for a reduction in building replacement value calculations for qualified, newly constructed public school buildings... and requires that these buildings be designed with an Integrated Design process and have Fundamental Building Commissioning performed. The code also directs the Division of Building Safety (DBS) to assist schools in accessing the technical and educational support needed to implement the processes of integrated design and fundamental commissioning. DBS has promulgated IDAPA Rule 07.03. 01.038 to provide this information. It states that DBS maintains a list of qualified Commissioning Agents who are certified by the Building Commissioning Association (BCA). The BCA's Certification Program does not require the individual to be a PE, but PEs are able to become certified. The Board previously addressed this commissioning issue in response to an inquiry by DPW in 2001. The subcommittee members will monitor the DBS website to see that the language is updated. There is no updated information on this item at this time.

3. Mr. Szatkowski discussed progress with the procedure for CPD auditing.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Howe to approve the draft audit plan. Motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

1. Reports by Board Members and Staff of activities since the April Board meeting.

2. Staff presented an Expense Reimbursement Summary for the Executive Director from April 1, 2011 through May 31, 2011 for the Board's review.

5. The Society for Mining, Metallurgy and Exploration (SME) would like the Idaho Board to oppose the Master's or Equivalent requirement for licensure.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to note this item and file. Motion passed unanimously.

7. Bill Custer would like the Board to clarify if a surveying course would be considered "engineering science" for the IDAPA requirements.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize the Chair to write a letter to inform Mr. Custer that engineering surveying courses are not listed as engineering science in typical ABET accreditation processes, so the Board does not consider them to

be engineering sciences. Engineering science is the engineering application of basic scientific principles. Motion passed unanimously.

10. Does the Board want to appoint Gary L. Young, P.E./L.S. as an Emeritus Member under Idaho Code Section 54-1203 to assist in implementation and transition to the amendments contained in House Bill No. 132?

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Howe to appoint Mr. Young as an Emeritus member to assist in the surveying and engineering areas he specializes in. Motion passed unanimously.

11. Staff prepared a draft NEWS BULLETIN for the Board's review.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Bennion to approve the NEWS BULLETIN as amended and publish. Motion passed unanimously.

12. The MBA's distributed a questionnaire about the cost of CBT for FE/FS examinations.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Wagner to notify the MBA Networking Group that the Board reviewed the draft resolution, anticipates learning more about it at the annual meeting, but will not support it at this time in its current form. Motion passed unanimously.

13. Mr. Milligan informed the Board that he has a conflict with the dates set for the November meeting, currently November 17-19, 2011. He requested the Board consider changes to the meeting dates.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Elle to reschedule the November meeting to November 7-9, 2011. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Elle to require that cell phones be turned off during meetings. Motion passed unanimously.




