Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors held a regular meeting on August 4 - 5, 2011 at the Salmon Rapids Lodge in Riggins, Idaho to conduct Board business. The meeting convened at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 4, 2011 with the following Board members present: James H. Milligan, David Bennion, John Howe, George Wagner, and John Elle. Also present was David L. Curtis, Executive Director and Jim Szatkowski, Deputy Director.

**i. AGENDA REVIEW**

Are there any new agenda items? George Wagner requested that the Board add an agenda item to discuss a concern expressed by Tom Ruby. The Board added this to the agenda as NEW BUSINESS ITEM #7.

**II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA**

None

**III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

1. At the last meeting, staff was directed to gather information from nearby jurisdictions on what types of projects are restricted to individuals that hold an SE license.

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Wagner to form a task force with the structural engineers to investigate and explore the idea and allow that committee to expand to other potential stakeholders as necessary. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Milligan appointed Mr. Elle, and Mr. Bennion to serve on the subcommittee.

2. Lance King requested a one year extension to complete the requirements of the FINAL ORDER issued February 10, 2010 relating to his request for a PLS license.

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Elle to amend the ORDER to allow him until December 31, 2012 to complete the terms. Staff to check with Mr. Kane to see if a formal amended ORDER needs to be prepared. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **IV. NEW BUSINESS**

2. Personnel Costs are underfunded for FY12 due to a 5% budget reduction from the previous year. However, due to the pending retirement of Mr. Curtis, we have reserve funds in personnel to cover the 5% deficiency. Mr. Curtis will not be retiring in FY12 and DFM has given us authorization to use those funds for any legitimate state employee salary and benefit expense. The Board noted the information.
3. NCEES will be implementing a policy of allowing an assigned candidate to sit for three administrations of the FE and FS computer-based tests unless instructed otherwise by the assigning Board. Does the Board want to consider changes to Idaho Code to allow three attempts per assignment before requiring additional education and/or experience?

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Howe to reconsider this issue when NCEES has implemented the policy. Motion passed unanimously.

4. The Board reviewed input from the Public Hearing as well as written comments regarding the Proposed Rules in IDAPA 10.01.01, 10.01.02, and 10.01.04. A discussion took place relating to PDH requirements for civilian license holders deployed with the military and the Board favored the modification suggested by staff.

Moved by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Elle to accept the modifications as noted with the exception of the "may and shall" issue at the end of the "discovery of error" paragraph in Docket 10-0102-1101. Motion passed unanimously.

5. If someone changes to retired status within a biennium and then they are selected for audit (or would have been if they hadn't changed status) should they still be required to provide CPD records?

Moved by Mr. Bennion, seconded by Mr. Howe to authorize staff to waive a possible CPD audit if someone chooses to retire during the period for which they may or are being audited unless there is a disciplinary matter pending or in progress. Motion passed unanimously.

6. Chairman Milligan and Mr. Curtis have been invited to attend the APEGBC meeting in Kelowna, BC in October. Does the Board want to approve their attendance?

Moved by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Bennion to authorize Mr. Curtis and Mr. Milligan to attend the meeting. Motion passed unanimously.


